



## Intention of Pupil Premium Spending 2015-2016

This year the Academy has received £213,924 Pupil Premium funding. This funding will be used in the following ways:

Appointment of Parent Support Advisor with a specific focus on increasing attendance of our Pupil Premium children as well as supporting pupils with behavioural, social and educational needs.	£18,023
Appointment of Learning Mentor to provide support the individual needs of Pupil Premium children.	£18,023
Rewards for Attendance	£5,000
Teaching Assistants employed to support work with groups of Pupil Premium children through an enhanced curriculum providing opportunities to develop a range of skills and experiences such as gardening, painting, wood-working. This will link to basic skills in Literacy and Mathematics across the all key stages.	£29,500
Teaching assistants to carry out reading interventions and phonics support for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium	£30,000
The funding of enrichment opportunities such as The Dig Project, visit to White Scar Caves and Abbey House Museum, to ensure all pupils have a broad and balanced curriculum	£14,350
Support the funding of residential visits	£3,000
Uniform	£5,000
Purchase of 30 Netbooks to support and raise attainment of children in Reading, Writing and Maths -	£11,000
Access to Wider Opportunities music lessons for Pupil Premium children in Key Stage 2 to learn to play an instrument -	£5,000
Booster group support for eligible pupil premium children in Yr 6, Yr 5 and Yr 2	£5,000
Equipment and resources to support the teaching and learning of interventions	£10,000
Supplementing the reading scheme in school	£5,000
Subsidising Breakfast Club for Pupil Premium children including staff salaries and equipment	£15,300
Fruit for all pupil premium children daily in KS2	£5,000
To provide wraparound care by extending childcare for school aged pupil premium children, to include after school sessions.	£35,000
Qualified coaches to run after school clubs to target pupil premium children to raise awareness of health, fitness, commitment to a sport.	£3,500

The majority of pupils who are eligible for Pupil Premium make good progress at Heath View Academy. Our targets for the end of Year 6 are for 100% to make at least 2 levels of progress in Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
