Around the World inspire



Literacy: We are working towards writing an independent sentence. We will be encouraging the children to listen for the sounds in the word and practising writing a sentence using capital letter, finger space and full stop. In phonics we will be looking at phase 3 sounds and practising reading words with diagraphs (two letters makes one sound).



Mathematics: This half term we are very busy with lots of different maths concepts. We will be introducing the children to money and identifying and adding with coins. We are looking at weight and capacity and using positional language to find objects and give directions. We will be looking for patterns in the environment and making our own patterns. Also we will be doubling and halving



Understanding of the world: We will be looking at a map of the world and discussing and comparing different countries and continents. Exploring different weather, food, plants and animals from different countries

Topic: Our topic this half term is All Around the World. Each week we will look at a different continent. We will be tasting food, listening to music and practising dances from different countries. Hopefully these should provide interesting conversations at home and inspire the children's writing



Personal, Social & Emotional Development: Our school focus this half term is 'enjoy a challenge'. We will be encouraging the children to discuss what they are good at and focusing on preserving and having the confidence to complete challenges independently. Within our topic we will be encouraging the children to try new things.
